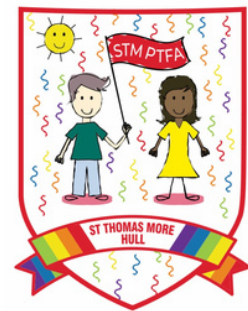


STM PTFA Newsletter- Autumn 2025



A little hello

Some of you may not know us yet so we'd like to say hello and tell you a little about the PTFA.

We formed a little over 4 years ago and have raised **£25,242** by holding fundraising events throughout the school year.

We are governed by a Parentkind model constitution and are a **registered charity**.

We aim to run fun events for our pupils as well as making special memories all while raising much needed funds for our school.

What we raised last year

Last academic year we raised a total of **£4329** through our discos, fairs, frozen Fridays, lottery, easyfundraising, sports day sales, Christmas card sales, ASDA CashPot and clothes recycling scheme.

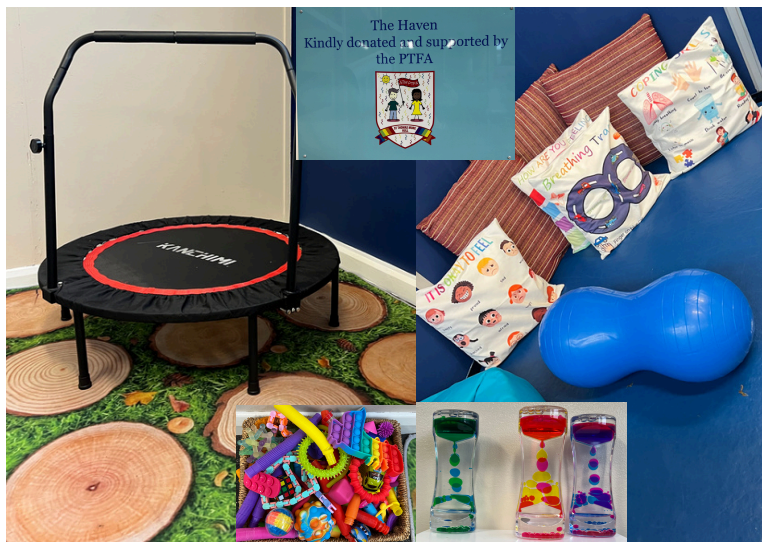


What we spent last year

Last year we spent **£1,296** on items and resources for the school.

This included **sensory room equipment**, **butterfly habitats and caterpillars** for FSU, stamps for FSU, **reading books** for KS2, year 6 celebration day and ice lollies on sports day.

Previous years, we've also installed the **trim trail** and **playground markings**, purchased books for all key stages and made improvements to the school allotment and prayer garden.

Sign up to **easyfundraising** to raise us money when you shop online. It's free and super simple to use. Last year we raised **£447** just from shopping! Friends and family can support us too!

Simply download the easyfundraising app and choose us as your chosen cause. Currently, for each new sign up via the app we automatically receive an extra £2 donation and when you raise your first £5 (remember it's purely done when you shop at no extra cost or effort for you) then they'll double it to £10!

How you can help

Join our lottery! Tickets are just £1 each and the weekly jackpot is £25,000! Go to **www.theparentslottery.org** and select our school to find out more and to buy tickets.

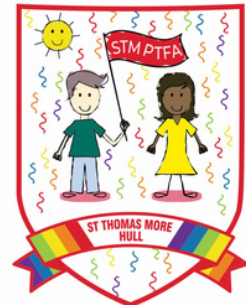
How you can help
